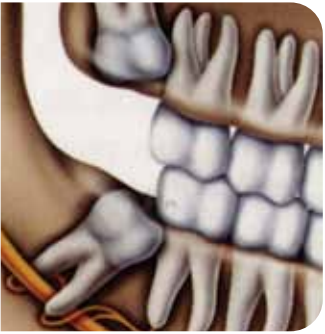
Welcome to the Office

Welcome to our office and thank you for allowing us to participate in your care. Your first visit will be for a consultation with Dr. Lee and his staff. It is important for Dr. Lee to meet you, review your past medical and dental history and determine what if any additional diagnostic studies are needed to treat you. We are pleased to introduce 3-D Dental Imaging to the Anderson area. This "game changing" x-ray technology may be important in your treatment and will be discussed at your first appointment.

Most routine oral surgery is done in the office in one of our dental operating rooms. If, for health reasons or because of the complexity of the surgery, the procedure needs to be performed at the outpatient facility at Mercy Anderson, Dr. Lee will discuss this with you as well. You will have an opportunity to review your dental/medical coverage with our financial coordinator at the end of your first visit. Financial arrangements are available.

Several different anesthetic techniques can be employed to accomplish your surgery. Your overall health and the complexity of your surgery impact upon the type of anesthesia that is used.

The Four Cornerstones of Our Practice



Oral Surgery

Central to our practice is the performance of routine oral surgery. These procedures include the removal of impacted wisdom teeth, the surgical removal of fractured and non salvageable teeth and the treatment of oral lesions, tumors and cysts. These procedures are performed with the aid of intravenous sedation and anesthesia.



Dental Implantology

Dental implants are now the standard of care for the replacement of missing teeth. Successful dental implant reconstruction requires the placement of the correct sized dental implant in the right position and at the right angle. Coordination with your dentist is paramount for success. Dr. Lee's staff includes a dental implant coordinator who facilitates a team approach to your dental implant treatment plan.



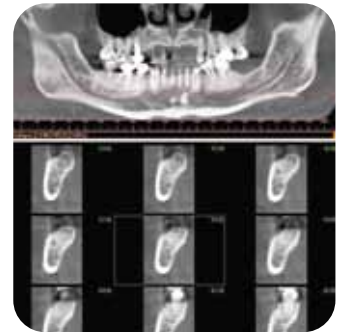
Orthognathic Surgery

Jaw reconstruction is an important part of Dr. Lee's practice. He has performed over 2000 jaw reconstructive procedures and focuses his practice to this specialty niche. An integral member of Dr. Lee's staff is his orthognathic surgery coordinator. Her role is to facilitate a team approach to jaw reconstruction. She coordinates your orthodontist with Dr. Lee and integrates the surgical treatment plan.



3-D Dental Imaging

Dental C-T scanning is now available in Cincinnati. Three dimensional imaging is vital for visualization of nerves, arteries, sinuses and adjacent teeth. It is critical for the successful surgical removal of deeply impacted wisdom teeth. This "game changing" technology allows Dr. Lee to accurately treatment plan complicated dental implant cases and jaw reconstructive procedures for obstructive sleep apnea.



About Our Staff

Our staff consists of two registered nurses certified in Advanced Cardiac Life Support. Three highly trained surgical technicians assist Dr. Lee in surgery. For those patients undergoing jaw reconstruction a special staff coordinator is assigned to manage your case and facilitate a team approach to your care. Our dental implant coordinator will manage your case and coordinate your care with your dentist. Our front office staff includes an insurance/financial coordinator who will assist you in establishing insurance benefits.

About Our Facility

Our surgical facility has been approved for office dental anesthesia by the Ohio Society of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeons in accordance to guidelines established by the American Association of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeons and the Ohio State Dental Board. Two operating suites and adjacent recovery rooms are available and fully equipped. All necessary anesthesia and resuscitative equipment is on hand and portable emergency equipment is on the premises for patient's safety in the waiting room and consultation areas. Recovery rooms staffed by our nurses and surgical assistants provide additional safety and assistance for the patient and their chaperone.
